



## **Political Director**

The New Hampshire Democratic Party is looking for a dynamic Political Director to develop, manage the Party's external relationships with state leaders, including but not limited to members of the legislature, grassroots activists, town/county committees and officials, and constituency advocates to mobilize support and activity for key races in 2022. The Political Director is responsible for leading our outreach efforts, working to bring more Granite Staters into our Party while supporting and activating existing relationships to achieve our mission. The Political Director will work closely with the Chairman, Executive Director, Communications Director, House and Senate Caucus Director(s), and Finance/Admin Director to ensure strong collaboration between departments and to prevent duplicity of efforts. The Political Director will serve as the Party's point of contact for allied organizations, including labor and affinity groups. They will attend partner organization meetings when appropriate, sharing the work of the Party and collaborating on efforts to maximize support for the Democratic ticket.

The Political Director will be responsible for building an engagement plan and overseeing a staff to execute said plan. This work will include engaging the NHDP State Committee and its Executive Committee, planning for the annual state convention, overseeing the engagement and expansion of youth organizations and affinity caucuses, managing the town and county caucuses, and serving as the point of contact for all local committees to support and empower their grassroots work, including any regular communications. They will also be the NHDP Staff person assigned to the state rules committee, the state platform committee, the executive committee, and the NHDP officers.

They will also assist the team in executing large scale events throughout the year and will follow legislative activity in the state and on the federal level. The Political Director

will also oversee planning of the annual state convention, and manage the town and county caucuses.

The Political Director reports to the Executive Director, and will lead the political department, including Deputy Political Directors, Outreach Directors, Grassroots Directors, and others, as needed.

- Ability to work with diverse constituencies, communities, and perspectives, including ability to facilitate coalition efforts to build consensus;
