- The ideal candidate has strong organizing skills, is tech-savvy, is knowledgeable with predictive dialer technology, such as ThruTalk/LiveVox and VPB Connect, texting tools, such as ThruText and Spoke, and has experience organizing and training large numbers of volunteers virtually.
- The ability to be scrappy when it comes to solving problems and using the resources you have already available to you.
- Strong communication skills and the ability to work well with volunteers.
- An excitement to meet people from your community and forge meaningful relationships with them.
- A passion to elect Democrats up and down the ballot.

Positions will be open until filled. This is a non-exempt position and is paid an hourly base rate of \$15.36 and a 1.5x overtime rate of \$23.04. Digital Organizers work a six day, 55 hour week and earn \$4,160 per month. This position includes a full benefits package, including a generous holiday and paid time off policy as well as health, vision, and dental insurance coverage at no monthly cost to the employee.
